Your Itinerary



DAY 1

ARANJUEZ / MADRID

Reception of passengers at 10:00 a.m. at a location to be determined in Madrid. Panoramic tour of Madrid and lunch in the capital. In the afternoon, we will transfer to Aranjuez, where the train awaits. Welcome toast and overnight stay on board. We will then visit the Royal Palace of Aranjuez and its gardens. A World Heritage Site, where history and beauty fill every corner of this royal site. Dinner on board. Overnight in Aranjuez.

DAY 2

ALCAZAR DE SAN JUAN / ARANJUEZ / TOLEDO

After breakfast, we will visit Toledo, a World Heritage Site that was once the most monumental Imperial city in Europe. The blend of Christian, Muslim, and Jewish architecture, with its architectural representations—the Gothic cathedral, the 10th-century mosque, and two synagogues—has given Toledo its universal character. Lunch in Toledo and free time before returning to the train in Aranjuez. While we dine on board, the train will arrive at Alcázar de San Juan. Overnight stay in Alcázar de San Juan.





DAY 3

ALCAZAR DE SAN JUAN / CÁCERES

After breakfast, we'll visit how two of the most famous products of this La Mancha region, internationally known for its cheeses and wines, are produced. We'll visit an artisanal cheese factory and a wine cellar. Lunch will be served in the area. In the afternoon, we'll visit Campo de Criptana, with its characteristic windmill landscape, a source of inspiration for Cervantes in his work Don Quixote. We'll return to Alcázar de San Juan, from where we'll depart by train, having dinner, to reach Cáceres. Overnight stay in Cáceres.

DAY 4

CÁCERES / JEREZ DE LA FRONTERA / MERIDA

After breakfast on board, we'll visit Cáceres, a World Heritage City, where the streets, squares, and palaces are magnificently preserved, thanks to its cultural mix that makes it a unique cultural experience. Later, we'll arrive by train for lunch in Mérida. In the afternoon, we'll visit this city of the ancient Roman Empire, also a World Heritage City, founded in 25 BC, where we'll explore its remains and history. While we dine on board, the train will depart for Jerez. Overnight stay in Jerez de la Frontera.



DAY 5

JEREZ DE LA FRONTERA

After breakfast, we'll enjoy the city and the show "How the Andalusian Horses Dance," a famous equestrian ballet set to Spanish music. Lunch will be served at a local restaurant, followed by an afternoon visit to a popular winery. Dinner on board and overnight stay in Jerez.

DAY 6

CADIZ / CORDOBA / JEREZ DE LA FRONTERA

After breakfast, we'll depart for Cádiz, popularly known as the "Silver Cup" and considered the oldest city in the West. Lunch will be served on board before the train arrives in Córdoba, where we'll visit its Mosque-Cathedral and continue our tour of what was once the capital of the medieval Emirate and Caliphate of Al-Andalus, when it was the largest, most cultured, and opulent city in Western Europe. Dinner and overnight stay in Córdoba.



DAY 7

CORDOBA / SEVILLE

After our final breakfast as we arrive in Seville, we'll bid farewell to the train and its crew. We'll visit Seville, home to the largest historic center in Spain. A World Heritage City, it boasts a wealth of art and beautiful gardens. The journey will end around 1:30 p.m.

PAYMENT TERMS:

15% of total tour cost due at the time of booking
85% or balance no later than 35 days prior to tour departure date

CANCELLATION FEES:

Up to 30 days before departure: refund less 15% of official price.

Between 30 and 15 days: refund less 25% of the total.

Between 14 and 5 days: refund less 50% of the total.

Between 4 and 1 day(s): refund less 80% of the total.

Less than 24 hours or failure to turn up: No refund, 100% of the total is payable.

A 5% Administrative fee will be charged from Palace Tours against any refunds. All cancellation fees and administrative fees is applicable for FULL Tour price before coupons.

CHANGE OF DATE/OCCUPANCY/NAME/SCHEDULE (not including changes to itinerary)

There might be a cost associated with any changes to a booking and the same will be communicated before the time of such change being processed or confirmed. 1 . What are the passport/visa requirements for travel to Spain?

Please ensure that your passport has at least three blank pages and that it is valid for at least six months beyond your departure date from Spain. Please check with your local embassy regarding visa requirements.

2 . What does my trip include?

Standard Suite:

- Accommodation in Standard Suite compartment on the train.
- The best food in dinners and lunches at top restaurants or on the train (including wine, coffee and spirits).
- Breakfast buffet and menu.
- Music and entertainment in the Pub coach.
- Programmed excursions with entrance to museums, cathedrals, cloisters, etc.
- Luxury coach accompanying the train all the way.
- Daily newspapers and magazines.
- Permanent security service.
- Multilingual guide throughout the tour.
- An excellent team at your disposal.

Superior Suite:

Everything included in the Standard Suite plus:

- Accommodation in Superior Suite on the train.
- Option of enjoying two private dinners/lunches in your compartment.
- All non-alcoholic beverages requested at any time throughout the trip.
- Transfers: including two Renfe transfers, one to take you to the starting point of the tour and another one to take you back from the end point of the tour.

3 . Is there a dress code on the train?

The dress code is casual, although you may dress up for dinner if you would like. We suggest packing comfortable walking shoes and layers of clothing, since the temperatures do fluctuate from day to night.

The size of the bed is dependent on the type of suite you reserve. Gran Clase with 2 beds will contain (1) bed that is 0.80 x 1.9 m and (1) bed that is 0.70 x 1.8 m and Suite Superior has one double/matrimonial bed that is 1.5 x 1.9 m If your suite has one extra bed, it is 0.70 x 1.8 m

7 . What is the difference between a Standard and Superior Suite?

Superior Suites - Features:

- Ample space distributed into a bedroom and bathroom.

- Two meter long double bed which can be turned into a sofa during the day.

- Possibility of adding an extra bed for a third passenger.

- Equipped with safe, varied minibar, wardrobe, luggage rack and climate control.

- Comfortable and spacious bathroom, with hairdryer and a varied set of welcome items.

Standard Suites are charming rooms that retain the dimensions and Belle Epoque charm of original compartments.

Features:

- A bedroom and bathroom layout.

- Two single beds which can be turned into armchairs during the day.

- Equipped with small minibar, safe, wardrobe, luggage rack and climate control.

- Functional bathroom, with maximum use of its space, equipped with shower and a hairdryer.
